2010 End of Season Tournament

The 2010 tournament will use Pool play in all leagues. All teams will be seeded in a pool with 2, 3 or 4 other teams based on each teams' regular season results. Teams will play 2 or 3 games against teams in their pool. Based on the results of these games teams will move on to the Semi-Finals.

Seeding based on Regular Season Results

Winning percentage out to 4 decimals (Wins divided by total games played). The team with the highest winning percentage will be seeded #1, and so on.

Teams with the same winning percentage will be seeded based on the following order of tiebreakers:

- 1 Number of wins
- 2 Number of ties
- 3 Head-to-head (total wins over the other team(s))
- 4 Average least runs allowed per game, excluding forfeits
- 5 Coin flip

Tournament Tiebreakers

Invariably with Pool play, playing just 2 or 3 games, teams vying for 1st or 2nd place in the pool will have the same record. A tiebreaker system is needed in order to determine the place winner.

- 1 Head-to-head in tournament (not used if 3 or more teams are tied)
- 2 Run differential*
- 3 Least total runs allowed in tournament
- 4 Seeding - the highest seed moves on

* Maximum differential for a game is + or - 6 runs. Ex. Team A beats Team B 7-4. Team A is credited with a +3 run differential and Team B with a -3 run differential. Team A beats Team B 16 to 4. Team A gets a +6 and Team B a -6. The differentials are added up for all tournament games. Forfeit games will not be included in the run differential calculations. If there is a forfeit for a playoff game, the league run differentials will be based on average run differentials for the games played.

Rained out Tournament games will be made up on the first available rain date. Teams should be prepared to play any day, including Saturday and Sunday. If many games are rained out it is possible that a team could be scheduled for a doubleheader on the weekend. Semi-final and final games may also be pushed back to accommodate tournament make-up games. The League will provide re-scheduled game dates and times as quickly as possible.
